The Gauge O Guild

The Gauge O Guild exists to encourage and assist modellers working in all areas of 7mm railway modelling from narrow gauge to tinplate and from Finescale to ScaleSeven. Whatever your interest you are assured of a warm welcome in the Guild, sure in the knowledge that membership is the ideal way of keeping in touch with everything in 7mm modelling.

To many people O gauge is the ideal size for railway modelling. The feel and weight of the locomotives and rolling stock greatly adds to the realism most railway modellers seek to re create. Even allowing for an increase in the space required, a reasonable layout can be built in a modern flat or house. For those with bigger ambitions, if an extension into the garden is practicable the possibilities of O gauge are vast.

Survival of the greatest

When the Guild was formed in 1956 O gauge was a seriously endangered scale, but thanks in no small part to the activities of the Guild, 7mm railway modelling now enjoys active trade support with the range and quality of kits and ready-to-run being the envy of those working in other scales. The Guild itself has flourished with nearly 6000 members worldwide. Now a UK private company limited by guarantee the Guild is still run by volunteers.

Benefits of membership

A quarterly full colour **Gazette** containing constructional articles, details and critical reviews of trade products, extensive trade advertisement, colour photos, line illustrations and much more besides. The Gazette is accompanied by an extensive **Guild News** containing information about national and local meetings worldwide. It also publicises, free of charge, members' private sales and wants providing a valuable source of models and

equipment. The Guild's other publications of manuals and handbooks are available to members on publication.

We hold the largest O Gauge show of the year, Guildex at Telford in Shropshire with many layouts, extensive trade support, hands on demonstrations and workshops in modelling techniques. The Guild also holds two other major O gauge shows each year at Kettering in March and Doncaster in June and supports several shows run by local groups. Admission to members is at a greatly reduced rate.

The **Technical Committee** provide support for modellers by trialling techniques and publishing the results. A full technical manual is available to members online and on CD.

The Guild has an extensive collection of Video and slides available on DVD and holds many drawings including the Edwards Brothers Collection.

The **Service for Executors and Trustees** is available to help dispose of deceased members' collections.

Local O Gauge Groups provide a meeting place for members and the Guild supports their activities.
